


1) Go to this site <https://chroniclingamerica.loc.gov/>


2) click on "Advanced Search"



3) Click inside the box that says "Or Select Newspaper(s)" Doesn't matter what gets highlighted, just click once inside that box. (Note: you DO NOT need to select the state)



4) Type "montg" rather quickly. This should result in "Montgomery County Sentinel" now being instantly highlighted (otherwise you have to scroll fofoooooorrrreeeevvveeeerrrrr to get to that title alphabetically-- this is just a shortcut to get to it)

5) Select your year range (or a more specific date range-- that's the option right below)

8) You can also sort the results-- "Relevance" is the default, but if you'd rather look at them in chronological order (Date), you can pick that instead from the dropdown.

9) Click on the thumbnail of the newspaper and a full-screen version will appear. You can then make it bigger to read it (use the +/- buttons), and move around the page (click and drag on the image) to find the exact column you want. When you're done with an issue, click the browser's back arrow to return to your results page. The titles of the issues you've already looked at will turn red.





10) To save a clipping you can either:

a) download the entire page (click "PDF")



b) center the text you want on the screen, which is mirrored in the red box thumbnail in the upper right corner. Then choose the little scissors ("snipping tool") icon



A new tab will appear, with your clipping as it came out, and you can choose "Print this image" or "Download this image" in order to save it.
