

**Guide to the Oral History of
HARTLEY, GILBERT V., M.D. (1894-1977)**

Biographical/Historical Notes

Gilbert V. Hartley was a general practitioner in Rockville, Maryland. He was born in 1894. He attended George Washington University Medical School. He came to Rockville in 1920 and was one of only five practicing physicians in the city. He managed a private medical practice in Rockville from the 1920s to through the 1960s. He also served as an on-call physician to the Montgomery County Almshouse in the 1930s and 1940s.
