

**Guide to the Oral History of
MORELAND, GEORGE B. (1901-1982)**

Biographical/Historical Notes

George B. Moreland was the Director of the Department of Libraries in Montgomery County. He was born in 1901 Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, where he was raised. He attended Princeton University, the University of Pittsburgh, and the Carnegie Library School. He held various positions with the Washington D.C. Public Library from 1936 to 1942 and again from 1946 to 1948. From 1943 to 1946, he was the librarian for the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy. In 1951, he became the Director of the Department of Public Libraries for Montgomery County, a position he held until his retirement in 1969. From 1956 to 1958, he also served as a library advisor to the Government of Pakistan.
