

**Guide to the Oral History of
ROVNER, EDMUND F. (1930-1992)**

Biographical/Historical Notes

Edmund F. Rovner was a Special Assistant to the Montgomery County Executive. He was born in 1930 in New York. He earned his law degree at Columbia University. Rovner worked as an Administrative Assistant on Capitol Hill, as head of Intergovernmental Relations for the National Governors Association, and as an Executive Assistant to the Governor of Maryland. From 1981 to 1986, he served as Special Assistant to the Montgomery County Executive. He also worked as a management consultant and taught management courses at Montgomery College.
