

**Guide to the Oral History of
SMITH, LUCY N. (1888-1980)**

Biographical/Historical Notes

Lucy N. Smith was a long-time resident and community volunteer in Rockville, Maryland. She born in 1888 in Washington, D.C. and raised in Rockville. She attended Miss Lucy Simpson's School (Rockville Institute) and the Washington College of Music. In 1916, she began working for the Veterans Bureau (which became the Veterans Administration and later the Department of Veterans Affairs). She worked there until 1955. As a resident of Rockville, Smith was a member of the Rockville Garden Club, Women's Club, and Historical Society.
