### **ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY**

The Office of Information and Research was formed in 1955 to advise the County Manager and other County Officials on matters of public concern, and to encourage public support and understanding of the County Government by operating the County's public information program. In 1962 the Office of Information and Research merged with the Office of Economic Development, and a new Office of Information was formed as a branch of the County Manager's Office. This office supplied news releases and photographs to local news media, and administered a public relations program. In 1970, when the County Executive replaced the Manager, the County Information Office came under the auspices of the Executive's office.

The Information Office is responsible for the establishment of a comprehensive information program which maintains a continuing flow of information to County residents through the press, radio, and television, clarifies controversial issues, promotes understanding of the methods of County government, provides public relations assistance to County agencies, and promotes tourism.

By the mid-1980s the County Information Office became an independent agency and was designated the Department of Public Information and Volunteer Services comprised of four sections: the Information Office, Publications and Graphics, Information and Referral, and Volunteer Services. When Volunteer Services was removed from the Department in the late 1980s, its name was changed to the Office of Public Information. Currently, the Office of Public Information consists of three sections. The Information Office Section provides information to the public about the activities of Montgomery County government; responds to media inquiries; produces a variety of publications; plans press conferences, groundbreakings, and other special events; produces proclamations and certificates of appreciation; and handles photography presentations. The Publications and Graphics Section provides design and production services and technical assistance for publications, forms, brochures, newsletters, and topical reports for County agencies. The Cable Programming Section, the latest addition to the Office of Public Information, coordinates programming and provides production assistance to County agencies in producing cable and video programs for County Cable 55.

### **SCOPE AND CONTENT**

The records of the Montgomery County Office of Public Information comprise materials covering the years 1969 to 2003. They consist of audio tapes of radio programs and video tapes and paper copies of press releases and public service announcements. The record group is arranged as three series:

### **SERIES DESCRIPTIONS**

#### **Series I: Audio Tapes, 1969-1980**

**(13.8 cubic feet)**

This series consists of audio tapes of radio programs produced by the Office of Public Information. The programs address a wide variety of topics, ranging from information about general topics such as state legislative activities and the energy crisis, to local issues such as the Montgomery County construction program. Also included are tapes of self-help programs covering topics such as auto repairs. The audio tapes are arranged chronologically by the date of broadcasting.

#### **Series II: Video Tapes, 1974-1975 and undated**

**(0.2 cubic feet)**

This series consists of video tapes produced by the Montgomery County Office of Information. The tapes contain programs on Black History, on Historic Women of Maryland, and also document the inauguration of County Executive James Gleason in 1974. This series is arranged alphabetically by the title of the program.

#### **Series III: Press Releases, 1962-2003**

**(9.33 cubic feet)**

This series consists of paper copies of press releases that were distributed by the Office of Public Information to the public media, county offices and employees. This series is arranged into four subseries: County Government Reports, Media Advisories, News Releases, and Public Service Announcements.

##### ***Subseries 1. County Government Reports, 1964 - 1966***

***(3 folders)***

This subseries consists of three folders that were included in the binders of press releases maintained by the Office of Public Information. These are reports that are two to four pages in length, released by the Director of the Department of Information and Economic Development. Reports were released as often as weekly to provide residents with information about County economic development. The subseries is arranged in chronological order.

##### ***Subseries 2. Media Advisories, 1996 - 1999***

***(0.3 cubic feet)***

This subseries consists of press releases that were sent to the public media via FAX, E-mail, and were accessible via the Internet. These advisories announced press conferences and photo opportunities to the media. Most are a single page containing the date, time, location, and a brief description of the nature of the event. Annual indices with event

date, title, and log number is included for each year. The subseries is arranged in numerical order by log number, which is approximately chronological by the anticipated event date. Media advisories that have no log number are interfiled chronologically. The annual index precedes the media advisories for that year.

***Subseries 3. News Releases, 1962 - 2003***  
***(8.3cubic feet)***

This subseries consists of press releases that were sent to representatives of the media, county employees, and members of the public via postal mail as well as by E-mail. Copies of these news releases were also made available on the Internet after December 1995. Annual indices with release number, title, and release date for each news release are included for many years. For the years 1977, 1979, 1980, and 1981, there is an additional folder labeled "Individual Departmental Releases." This folder contains photocopies of index tabs used as separators, labelled by County office, and followed by the news release material supplied by that department. The index tabs also had file labels affixed, indicating the release numbers of news releases that were produced for a specific County office.

The subseries is arranged in numerical order by release number, which is approximately chronological by release date. News releases that have no release number are interfiled chronologically. The annual index precedes news releases for that year. The individual departmental releases follow the chronological news releases for each year.

***Subseries 4. Public Service Announcements, 1981 - 1997***  
***(0.29 cubic feet)***

This subseries consists of public service announcements that were sent to radio and television stations. Annual indices with announcement number, title, and release date for each announcement are included for all years. The subseries is arranged in numerical order by announcement number.

Press releases through 1999 were transferred from the Office of Public Information in 2003. Recent copies of the press releases are received from the Office of Public Information as part of the public distribution process. ### **PROCESSING PROCEDURES**

General processing procedures consisted of discarding duplicates, unnecessary binders, and routine transmittals. Oversized documents and photographs were removed from the original location in their assigned series and placed in separate containers. Separation sheets were inserted in the original location within the folder to indicate the new location of any records placed elsewhere. Records in folders were arranged, unless otherwise indicated, in forward chronological order, with undated records appearing at the end of the folder.
