Joyce B. Siegel was a community leader in Montgomery County. She was born in Brooklyn, New York and came to Montgomery County in 1962. She attended Smith College, Towson State Teachers College, and the University of Maryland. She worked as a Head Start teacher. Siegel was active in numerous civic and community associations. She was Commissioner of the Montgomery County Housing Authority. She also served on the Boards of the Scotland Community Development, Inc. and the Community Action Committee and was a member of the League of Women Voters.
